
 Nestled into the woodlands between Morse Mountain and the Mount Mansfield State Forest, these condominium homes provide a balance between privacy and convenient access to lifts.

# **Accommodations – Logistics**



- Slope-side Condominiums (decorations and room configurations may vary as condos are privately owned)
- Condo space is rented on a per person basis, e.g. multiple people grouped per condo

#### **Housing Assignment Registration Deadline:**

- Submit deposit for chosen package by 5pm EST on Friday, January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013
- Complete additional room registration for housing and roommate preferences
   (This additional registration will be sent out mid-January 2013)
- 3. Please note prices are based on 8-12 people per condo. Final room assignments communicated to housing captains & individual attendees

# **Accommodations – Family**



#### Winter retreat rates are based on 8-12 person occupancy

- Families will be grouped together to meet the occupancy requirement
- Families will choose housemates using the roommate preference sheet that will be sent out in mid-January

#### Policy regarding children

- Children 6 & under are free as long as they don't occupy an actual bed in the condo (i.e. use of sleeping bag, pack 'n play, etc.). They will have access to meals
- Children over 6 or children who plan on engaging in the package activities (i.e. skiing, snowboarding, ice skating, etc.) will be charged as adults
  - Please note that you could purchase these services at the resort a la carte upon arrival.
